The SCRIP ROOM will be used ONLY FOR PICK UP! Thanks for your patience and cooperation!

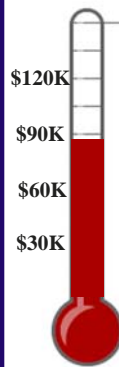


WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

STEPS FOR THE NEW ONLINE SCRIP ORDERING PROCESS:

- ◆ A new interactive scrip order form is available on the St. Mary Parish website: www.churchofsaintmary.org.
- ◆ To place a scrip order go to the website and click the “SCRIP” button and click the link to the scrip ordering form.
- ◆ Complete the form and click the “send” button.
- ◆ Your order will be filled and ready for pickup at the place and day you choose. Orders must be placed by Thursday noon for pickup at the Scrip Room during the weekend Masses.
