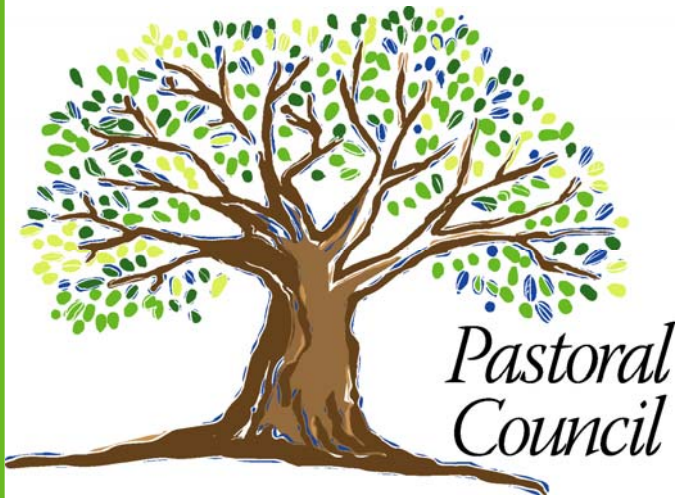

What is Pastoral Council?

Pastoral Council is a consultative body whose purpose is to assist the Pastor in areas of pastoral concern, draw our parishioners to a closer relationship with Jesus, and to serve God, each other and all people.

Why do we have a Pastoral Council?

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia requires all parishes to have a Pastoral Council that the council may inform the Pastor of the needs and concerns, gifts and resources of the whole parish and its members. Therefore, the Pastoral Council participates in ongoing pastoral planning for the good of our parish.

Who serves on the Pastoral Council?

The Pastoral Council is made up of the Pastor, Ex-Officio members, 3 members appointed by the Pastor and 6 members elected by the parishioners. Appointed members serve a 3 year term and may be reappointed by the Pastor at his discretion. Elected members serve a 3 year term and the terms rotate so each year 2 positions come up for election.
