OFFICIAL NAME OF THE PARISH: When I arrived as your pastor 3 years ago (July 1, 2013) many people asked me the official name of our parish. They would see: St. Mary the Virgin, The Church of Saint Mary, St. Mary's, etc. Well, the official name of our parish is Saint (spelled out) Mary (and NO apostrophe s). We are a Roman Catholic Church of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia so, the official longer title is **Saint Mary Roman Catholic Church**. It is on the cover of our bulletin. I hope this settles the question of "Father, what is the name of our Church/Parish?" We were founded on September 15, 1926. We presently have 2100 households registered with 7000 members. Our area used to be called Delphi, now it is known as Schwenksville. We are in Western Montgomery County and in Deanery #5 of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Sandi Olzinski, our parish secretary has notified the envelope company so our envelopes will be changed soon as well.

SUNDAY COLLECTION: We rely and depend greatly on the Sunday collection for 52 Sundays and 6 Holy Days of Obligation. 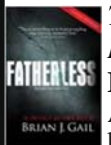
