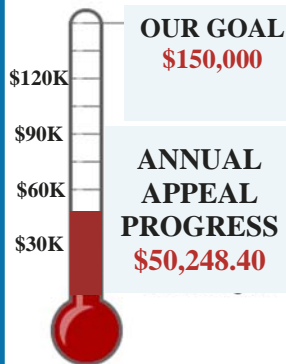
STEUBENVILLE YOUTH CONFERENCE

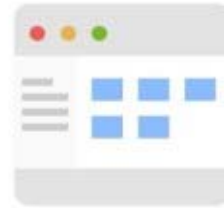
