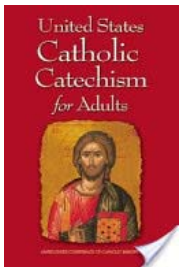

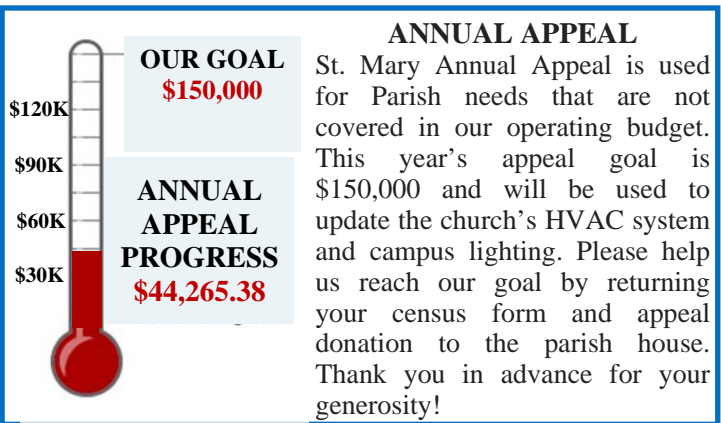
### CANDY MISSION TO FIX OUR KITCHEN

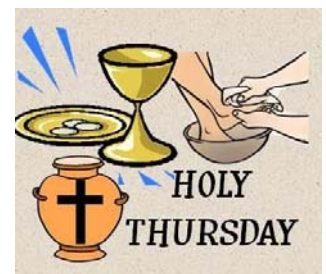
