ANGEL TREE

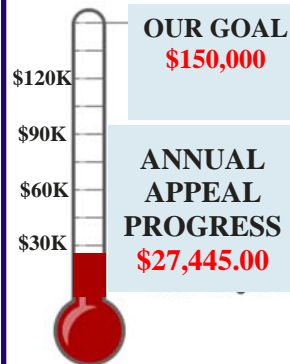
