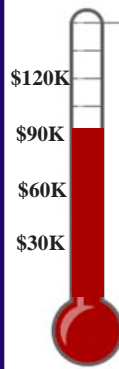

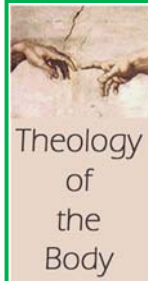
TROOP 50 LOOKING FOR NEW SCOUTS
